



Muskegon County Habitat for Humanity helps God's people in need by providing decent, affordable houses to eradicate poverty housing in Muskegon County. We are currently selecting families for homes to be built in 2010 on tentative sites in Muskegon, Muskegon Heights and White Lake.

Muskegon County Habitat for Humanity is an ecumenical, faith based housing ministry. Homebuyers work at least 400 hours to help build homes or on other projects to further the ministry of Habitat for Humanity. They work with volunteers who build and renovate houses as their expression of God's love. Faith communities, individuals, businesses, and other groups contribute the funds. When complete, homes are sold to successful applicants at cost and 0% interest over 20 - 25 years. To be selected as a homeowner, applicants must have household incomes of between 25% and 50% of the area median income.

To apply:

Complete and Submit a Pre-Qualification Form which explains the program and qualifications. Forms are available from Muskegon County Habitat for Humanity located at 280 Ottawa Street or by calling 727-6020.

Qualified families will then:

Receive an application and schedule an in-take appointment.
