Here's a real life story of a 16 year old mother of twins.

Agirina and her 2 brothers Dinis and Momade lost their mother 3 years ago. Their father cared for them well until he died in 2008, then leaving them with an aunt. In 2009 when the aunt passed away it left Agirina in desperation and she accepted a marriage proposal from a man in her village. She became pregnant with twins (which she was unaware of). So at planting time in December 2009, she asked her husband for help. Her husband refused and said it was woman's work and he abandoned her and her brothers. In Mozambique the motto is "No field, no food, no life" as there are no agency to go to for food help. Her twins, Petrito 1 and 2 were born in May. Agirina did the best she could but ran out of food and her breast milk could no longer support her baby boys. Someone had told her about Mama Brenda in Balama. Brenda said "We were able to buy her a mud hut for \$600 the very next day for this little family, because several people gave generously for such an emergency as this. A foster mother was located and a huge load was lifted from the shoulders of this brave 16 year old girl. We at Orphans Unlimited were sent by God to do this for 1000's of orphans in the remote areas of northern Mozambique. With your help God's vision is coming to life as we now provide food and clothing for over 1,500 children in 30 villages over 2 counties."
